
Mr. Stripes, who is working as a founder of Kelantan Agro, is going to work as usual in a busy city.

Mr. Stripes' secretary is busy with the deadlines for the submission of documents for project approval.




Unfortunately, the project is met with fierce protest from the villagers.

Mr. Stripes feels sad, because his proposal does not acquire approval from the villagers.




Due to the pandemic, the government implemented the Movement Control Order (MCO) in the country.

Many shops remained closed as business are prohibited.


Many became unemployed during this MCO period.




The prime minister chairs an emergency cabinet meeting in an attempt to solve the current nation's crisis.

The community realizes the project would benefit them by providing employment opportunities. The community also accept the project.




Mr. Stripes is extremely delighted with the news that the land reclamation project is approved.
