Saddiq owns a piece of land at lakeside to carry out his agriculture plantations such as mangoes. His plantations were smooth sailing until development started to rise around the region.








The government then conducts EIA to compare the environmental and economical feasibility between agricultural sector and luxurious condominiums.




During the virus outbreak, Saddiq is still allowed to continue his operation and ensure that there is continuous supply of sufficient agricultural products for the community.












The local authority finally realizes the importance with the continuation of agricultural sector and decides to cancel their project and return the land to the farmer.
