Fishermen facing hard times due to land reclamation works

MELAKA: Reclamation works especially in Melaka Tengah area have caused significant damage to the ecosystem and affected the fishing industry, said state executive councillor Norhizam Hassan Baktee.

The state Agriculture, Entrepreneur Development and Agro-Based Committee chairman said fishermen are also facing financial constraint and had not receive adequate compensation.

"Only RM5mil of the RM29mil allocation were distributed to the fishermen since 2010," said Norhizam after a dialogue session with fishermen and agencies including the Fisheries Department and the Malaysia Maritime Enforcement Agency (MMEA) at Pulau Melaka yesterday.

"These allocations are meant for maintenance and repair of their boats as well as fishing nets," he said.

Norhizam added that the state government could do little except monitor the legal aspects of the reclamation projects because the agreements were signed between the previous state government and the local companies.

There are currently over 1,200 licensed fishermen in Melaka Tengah district.

































Raj and Wong decided to visit the polluted beach.
